

H1N1 Vaccine Clinic Information**

The Naugatuck Valley Health District will be offering public clinics for the H1N1 flu vaccine. Please check this page frequently to see when new clinics have been announced.

These public clinics are available to any District resident, **free of charge**, who wishes to receive it and cannot get the H1N1 flu vaccine from another source, such as their primary care provider. Vaccine is no longer restricted to the previously outlined priority groups. ([December 15, 2009 memo](#)) Residents of non-district towns are requested to call their primary care physicians or their local health department for information regarding their H1N1 clinic schedules.

Parents who need to schedule appointments for children needing the H1N1 vaccine or booster doses may call the NVHD office at (203) 881-3255. These appointments will be scheduled during regular weekly immunization clinics at NVHD on Tuesday afternoons.

Please print and fill-out a **vaccine registration form** in [ENGLISH](#) or [SPANISH](#) and bring the completed registration form with you when you receive your vaccination.
