

Nail Technician Training & Record

Pursuant to Naugatuck Valley Health District Body Code Section A (23) the Qualified Nail Technician (QNT) of a nail establishment is responsible for ensuring training of all nail technicians. Training shall include but is not necessarily limited to: ***Instruction in proper disinfection of equipment; disposal of single-use equipment; prohibited equipment and products; personnel hygiene; services that require CT state license.***

The Qualified Nail Technician shall maintain written documentation of a training program, and training records of individual employees, and shall make these records available to NVHD upon request.

The Qualified Nail Technician is responsible for completing and maintaining the employee training sheet and training record forms or substitute forms with similar content approved by NVHD.
