May is Mental Health Awareness Month

Did you know that 1 in 5 Americans live with a mental health condition?

Each year, millions of Americans face the reality of living with a mental illness. The Naugatuck Valley Health District is joining the national movement to raise awareness about mental health. We will fight the stigma, provide support, educate the public, and advocate for policies that support people with mental illness and their families!

During the month of May, NVHD staff will be participating in a Mental Health First Aid training. Mental Health First Aid helps someone experiencing a mental health or substance use-related crisis. Our staff will

learn risk factors and warning signs for mental health and addiction concerns, strategies for how to help someone in both crisis and non-crisis situations, and where to turn for help. Future dates for the public to participate in this training will be released at a later date.



In addition to First Aid Mental Health training, NVHD will be hosting a QPR Gatekeeper Training Course for suicide prevention. In this training, QPR will teach participants the warning signs and common causes of suicid-Together, we can realize our shared vision of all behavior while empowering them to safely question, persuade, and refer (QPR) someone who may be thinking about suicide. Two dates and times are being offered. The courses are as follows:
