IMMUNIZATIONS, IMMUNIZATIONS, IMMUNIZATIONS!

August is National Immunization Awareness Month, better known as NIAM. NIAM celebrates immunizations and their importance in helping to keep people of all ages healthy. This can be achieved by receiving vaccines like Hepatitis B and Varicella (chickenpox) if you are an infant/baby, Meningococcal and HPV vaccines during the preteen years, Tdap vaccine if you are pregnant, and Pneumococcal and Shingles vaccines if you are a senior. If you are age 6 months and up, do not forget to stay up-to-date with your Flu and COVID-19 vaccines!



There is a lot of information available about vaccines. Always remember to go to credible resources if you have questions. The first person you should ask about vaccines is a physician (i.e., your child's doctor or an adult's primary care physician). If you choose to go online looking for information, <u>www.immunize.org</u> is an excellent resource as well as the CDC at <u>https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/</u> index.html.

Throughout the month of August, the Naugatuck Valley Health District will be posting vaccine information on our social media pages to stress the importance of vaccines for all ages. Do not hesitate to use #ivax2protect to show your support for vaccines on your own social media pages!

VALLEY COMMUNITY INDEX-WE WANT YOUR INPUT!


NVHD is currently working with Griffin Hospital and other Valley partner organizations on the development of our new

version of the community health assessment, The Valley Community Index (Index). Updated every three years, Index looks at critical elements in the well-being of Valley residents. Community residents give input through a well-being survey

and through a number of "community listening sessions" conducted in partnership with Valley partner organizations. The Index will be released in a meeting – open to the public – on November 15. The Index then serves as the basis for a new Naugatuck Valley Community Health Improvement Plan
